For You

- Riding clothes – riding pants or jeans, etc.
- Riding Helmet
- Sunscreen
- Cap or hat
- Boots
- Spurs (if you have them)
- Bath towels and wash cloths (linens will be provided)
- Rain Gear
- Personal items (soap, hair products, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.)

Your Horse

- Negative Coggins and Medical Records Required
- Tack including but not limited to, saddle, pad, bridle, brushes, fly spray, rope halter and lead
- Feed, feed supplements and hay for your horse
- 2 buckets for your horse
- Shavings for your stall will be provided but additional bags can be purchased on site.

Each student will be responsible for the feeding and care of their horse and stall.

Students are welcome to bring their cell phones but with respect to the trainer, all phones must be on turned off or on vibrate during program hours.

Apprenticeship Program

The Apprenticeship Program is limited to only two (2) advanced level students. Each student will learn all aspects of running an equine business including grooming, tacking, starting colts, working with problem horses, ground work, cleaning stalls, barn maintenance and medical care. Each student is allowed to bring one (1) horse. Students must provide their own feed and hay. Shavings will be provided but extra shaving may be purchased on site.

Students will stay on location at the Dan Keen Horsemanship Bunkhouse. All meals will be provided. Students may bring their favorite snacks and beverages.

Students will arrive Sunday evening, July 26th (anytime after 3:00 P.M.). Sunday evening will consist be set-up and orientation. The program will begin Monday morning at 7:00 A.M. and end Thursday, July 30th at 5:00 P.M.
